"In 2006, I sold out of The House of Golf to my partners because I found the importing and wholesaling side of the business far more challenging than retail," Craig said. "I purchased out their interest in Byron and renamed it Byron Golf CGS and broadened the focus of the company ... Over time, CGS was the Australian distributor for brands such as OGIO, Etonic, Volvik, Champ, Nicklaus Golf and Powakaddy."

"I have also always loved golf and still love to play as much as ever," Craig said. "I have always been ultra competitive so golf has always provided a competitive fix. I also greatly enjoy the social side and getting out with friends and I genuinely can enjoy a day out regardless of whether I play to expectations or not."
